

QUICK REFERENCE FOR ALL SECTORS

Sanitary Environment



In general, coronaviruses do not survive long on objects and surfaces. They will last a few hours on inert objects with dry surfaces and a few days on inert objects with moist surfaces. To limit the risk of contact with contaminated surfaces, in addition to the usual cleaning of the workplaces, more frequent cleaning of surfaces in contact with the hands is recommended (e.g. stairway railings, doorknobs, elevator buttons).

So that the workers present in the work environment are protected from COVID-19:

efficient operation and maintenance of the ventilation systems are ensured, according to the regulatory requirements for the type of facility and the tasks performed;

the sanitary facilities are cleaned at least every shift;

the sanitary facilities are disinfected at least once a day;

the meal areas are cleaned after each meal;

the meal areas are disinfected daily;

the frequently touched surfaces (tables, counters, doorknobs, faucets, toilets, showers, bathrooms, locker rooms, telephones, computer accessories, etc.) are cleaned at least every shift;

the tools and equipment used are cleaned at least after every shift or when they must be shared;

usual housekeeping products are used for cleaning in accordance with the directives;

non-essential objects (magazines, newspapers and knickknacks) are removed from the common areas.
