## Exclusion from the Workplace (isolation of workers)



### So that the workers present in the work environment are protected from COVID-19:

the workplace exclusion rules for workers exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms are posted in the common areas;

the workers are informed about the workplace exclusion rules provided for in the company;

**NOTE :** \_\_\_\_\_

the workers exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms are identified before they enter the workplace (e.g. questionnaire<sup>1</sup>; self-evaluation by the workers);

**NOTE :** \_\_\_\_\_

the individuals more at risk of developing a serious illness after a COVID-19 infection are invited to follow the Government's recommendations. These are persons who are immunocompromised, suffer from chronic diseases and age 70 and over;

the workers are informed that in case of symptoms of cough or fever, difficulty breathing, sudden loss of smell or taste without nasal congestion or any other symptom associated with COVID-19, they must not report to work;

a procedure is established when a worker starts feeling symptoms in the workplace: isolate the worker in a room, have him or her wear a procedure mask and call the COVID-19 line at 1-877-644-4545. This event must be recorded in the company's register of accidents, incidents and first aid;
